Dear Mr. Banks:

Thank you for your letter of October 18th. After careful review, neither I nor our counsel feel that it directly answers the questions I posed in my letter to Commissioner Marcus. Please allow me to rephrase them:

In the County's view, was Juno Isles an enclave prior to 2004?

If so, why?

If not, how did the 04 annexation of the environmental parcel make it an enclave and,

Why was it permitted since it would have violated FS171?

As you consider your answers please keep the following two points in mind: FS 171 defines an enclave only as an area enclosed within a *single* municipality and, in discussing permissible voluntary annexations, it exclusively uses the term "enclave". The term "pocket" does not appear anywhere in the statute and, therefore, would seem to have no relevance to this discussion.

I hope our questions can be answered as simply and directly as they have been posed. I look forward to your response.
