Dear Commissioner Marcus:

I was informed by your office yesterday that County counsel has decided the County will not oppose the proposed annexation of Holy Spirit Lutheran Church to Juno Beach. I was told his opinion is based on the belief that Juno Isles is already an enclave as a result of Juno Beach's 2004 annexation of the environmental lands on the east side of Ellison Wilson road. If that is so, I respectfully request answers to the following questions:

How, exactly, did the annexation of the 2004 parcel create an enclave when, as County counsel previously specified, it did not include any portion of Ellison Wilson road thereby preserving egress without travelling through Juno Beach?

If the 2004 annexation did create an enclave, why didn't the County oppose it since it would have been a clear and blatant violation of Florida Statute 171.044?

How is it that County counsel was able to assure us that the recent annexation of Donald Ross road did not create an enclave when he is now saying that we have been an enclave since 2004?
